St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church (1863) In 1989 the church merged with Holy Cross Lutheran, 304 South, Collinsville 62234 [MO Synod] and was called Holy Cross Chapel. Arrangements are underway to become separate once again. The Chapel is located at 8705 New Bunkum Rd., Caseyville 62232.

Unity Lutheran, 4200 Caseyville Ave., East St. Louis 62204 [MO Synod] (1974) Name of this church was established after the merger of St. John's Lutheran and Trinity Lutheran, all records on location.
